Department of the State Policy in Civil Aviation of the Ministry of Transport of Russian Federation presents its compliments to the Directorate General of Civil Aviation of the Ministry of Transport of the Republic of Turkey and acknowledges receipt of your letter B.11.1.SHG.00.13.01.04/267 2389 dated 24 February, 2011.

At your request, we positively considered the increase on the basis of reciprocity for designated airlines of the Russian Federation and the Republic of Turkey on the agreed route Istanbul – Krasnodar and v.v. total number of weekly regular operations from 3 (three) to 5 (five) flights per week starting from IATA 2011 Summer Season.

The Department proposes that your letter dated 24 February, 2011 and this letter constitute the understanding reached between the aeronautical authorities of the Russian Federation and the Republic of Turkey, which comes into effect on the date of the present letter.

Turkish Directorate General of Civil Aviation presents its compliments to Department of State Policy in Civil Aviation, Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation.


We have been informed by Pegasus Airlines that 3 frequencies weekly operations of the Airline on the route of Istanbul (Sabiha Gökçen)-Krasnodar v.v. do not meet the demand of the passengers especially on holiday seasons.

Pegasus Airlines is planning to increase its weekly 3 frequencies operations to 5 frequencies on the route of Istanbul (Sabiha Gökçen)-Krasnodar v.v. from 2011 IATA Summer Season in order to meet the demand.

On the basis of Paragraph 3 of the Article 10 of the Air Transport Agreement signed between our countries on 29 August 1967 "The agreed services provided by the designated airlines of the Contracting Parties shall bear a close relationship to the requirements of the public for transportation on the specified routes and.... "; I kindly ask you to consider positively increasing the frequency entitlements of the designated air carriers of our countries on the mentioned route above and to be specified as 5 frequencies per week.
