

**RECORD OF DISCUSSIONS
BETWEEN
THE AERONAUTICAL AUTHORITIES OF
THE REPUBLIC OF TURKEY
AND
THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION**

1. The Delegations representing the Aeronautical Authorities of the Republic of Turkey and the Russian Federation (hereinafter referred to as "The Delegations") met in Moscow on 14-15 of October 2014 to review their civil aviation relations and to evaluate new avenues for further developing the regulatory framework for air services between the two countries.

Discussions were held in a friendly and cordial atmosphere.

The composition of the two Delegations is given as Attachment A.

2. The issues discussed are as follows:

- multi-designation or at least double designation for the routes specified,
- specifying new points of destination,
- increase of frequencies,
- transferring unused frequencies to the other routes,
- the use of airspace of the Russian Federation (Transsiberian ATS network and Rostov FIR).


3. The Delegations agreed on the followings:

- Any operations of Turkish carriers to the point of Sochi could be without any limitations, including the 5th freedom traffic right for three IATA seasons, beginning from the IATA Winter Season 2014-2015.
- Aeronautical Authorities of the Russian Federation are ready to extend the existing permission of the Pegasus Airlines on the route of İstanbul S. Gökçen – Mineralnye Vody with 4 weekly frequencies on a temporary basis during the IATA Winter Season 2014-2015.
- Turkish designated carrier shall be allowed to carry out additional 7 round trip frequencies of operations along Transsiberian ATS network to Osaka in accordance with the existing commercial agreement with Russian designated carrier.
- Russian and Turkish all cargo airlines shall be allowed the right of co-terminalization and triangle operation of points of origin on the own territory in frames of the existing traffic rights.
- The request of Turkish Delegation regarding to specify Chelyabinsk as a new point will be evaluated by Russian side.

- Both Delegations agreed that unresolved issues might be discussed between the Aeronautical Authorities during the next round of consultations next year in Ankara.


